



# **Starting strong**

### **Website Refresh**



With a Homes Guarantee as our north star, our policy team worked on a <u>letter</u> co-led by Senator Elizabeth Warren and Representative Jamaal Bowman, signed by over 40 Members of Congress, calling on the Biden Administration to use executive action to keep renters housed and crack down on price-gouging landlords. Our resolve to secure our Slate of Guarantees is as strong as ever – even in an unfavorable House and stagnant Senate. That includes pushing for a National Tenants Bill of Rights, using the appropriations process to address the housing crisis, and continuing to meet with the Biden Administration to explore solutions via executive action.
